Novel protein diets

Single source of protein

Egg (CDD) or Lamb (CDW/FDW)

› Minimizes the risk of allergic reaction

Single source of carbohydrates

ENVIRONMENTAL ALLERGIES

(atopy, eosinophilic granulomas, flea allergic dermatitis, pollen, mites, etc.)

PRIMARY SKIN BARRIER DEFECTS

(keratoseborrheic states, elderly animals, nutritional deficiencies,

Ratio Omega-6 / Omega-3 = 1

› Limiting inflammation and pruritus



Very high levels of Omega-3 (EPA and DHA) and Omega-6 (GLA)

› Reinforcement of the skin barrier, management of deficiencies

COMBINED ALLERGIES FOOD AND ENVIRONMENTAL

Ratio Omega-6 / Omega-3 = 1

› Limiting inflammation and pruritus

Very high levels of Omega-3 (EPA and DHA) and Omega-6 (GLA)

› Reinforcement of the skin barrier, deficiency management

SPECIFIC™ DIETS FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF ALLERGIC DERMATITIS

SUSPICION OF DERMATITIS OF ALLERGIC ORIGIN

2. Suspicion of atopy / flea allergic dermatitis / combined allergies

OBJECTIVE : remove the allergen AND improve skin barrier defence

No improvement

Partial improvement

Complete improvement

No improvement

Improvement

Check for other causes of allergies (see point 2)

Food allergy + other causes (eg atopy)

Confirmed diagnosis (relapse following a provocation*)

Check for other causes of allergies

Provocation test

Relapse = food allergy component

No relapse = atopy or DAPP
