Your dog has been diagnosed with otitis externa. This leaflet will explain what this condition is and how Osurnia will help.

### What is otitis externa?

Otitis externa is inflammation of the external ear.

The skin inside your dog's ear will be reddened and there may be a bacterial or yeast infection present.

### What causes otitis externa?

Some breeds of dog are more prone to ear infections due to the size or shape of their ears, other dogs get infections due to frequent swimming or hair growth in their ears.

If your dog regularly gets ear infections your vet may want to check for underlying conditions such as an allergy to something in the environment or their diet.









## What are the signs of otitis externa?

- Bad-smelling ears
- Ear scratching and/or head shaking
- Tilting the head
- Discharge from the ear
- Swelling or redness around the ear
- Reluctance to have their head touched

### What is Osurnia?
